February GKCTCC Meeting at Powell Gardens -- February 13, 2011

The first scheduled meeting for the year will take place on Sunday, February 13, 2011, 2:00 p.m., at Powell Gardens, 1609 N.W. U.S. Highway 50, Kingsville, MO. The meeting will take place in the multipurpose room, which is on the opposite end of the main building from the restaurant. Parking is available on back side of the complex. During that time we plan to vote on a slate of officers as approved in the November 2010 meeting. We need to decide the club activities for Tractor Daze that will take place at the National Agricultural Hall of Fame Saturday, July 9, 2011. Last year we had a great event and financially came out on the positive side. The activities included a tractor display, a garden tractor pull, an antique/classic tractor pull, two pedal tractor pulls, a parade of power, and tractor games. This year there has been some discussion at the Ag. Hall regarding additional activities during the day that would include a plowing demonstration and the Caterpillar club doing some dirt work. Hopefully this year the activities will follow a similar pattern along with the additional tractor type activities. Larry Richard from Arma, KS is available again with the "Draggin Wagon" and Phil Parson is available again with "Old Yeller" for the garden tractor pull. Dan Hanna will be making a presentation on the Sixth Annual Dream Factory Tractor Cruise that may take a different route in western Missouri on Saturday, May 7, 2011. The Schedule of Events for 2011 will be reviewed and then finalized at the April meeting. It is difficult to make the list accurate because some dates are changing without our knowledge, so it is important to call before loading the tractor.

Western Farm Show, Kansas City, MO -- February 25-27, 2011

The Western Farm Show is scheduled for February 25-27, 2011 at the American Royal Complex in Kansas City MO. In our November 2010 meeting it was determined the club would have four tractors as a part of the 40 foot display. Four styled John Deere tractors will include the following: a JD R (Duane "Spike" Spieker), a JD A (Glenn Ratzlaff), a JD B (Jerry Lee), and a JD H (Justin Read). Last year the Western Farm Show made some changes with their floor plan and placed all antique club activities on the upper floor. As a result of being on the upper floor we will have more space for our display. As in the past we also plan to have a display of toys along with pictures including a video display. November Meeting and White Elephant Auction - November 7, 2010

The meeting opened with the Star Spangled Banner and the flag salute.

President Hrabik introduced new members Bob and Debbie Surber from Belton, MO, and Larry Burton. Dan Hanna introduced his son and family, Jordan and Sissy Cobb along with their daughter, Izzi, who was our Dream Factory recipient last year.

The President asked for approval of the June 6, 2010 meeting minutes. Wes Storm moved and Bryce York seconded. Motion passed.

Bary Porter provided a brief financial report. Balance as of 6-30-10 was \$4,715.51. Took in dues, payment for hats (Tractor Daze), sled rental, mailings and MO State Fair parade prize with balance of \$4,989.02 for 10-31-10. Bryce York moved to approve. Dan Hanna seconded. Motion passed.

The President asked for the slate of officers for 2011. Past officers for 2010 are Don Hrabik (President), Bryce York (1st Vice President), Wes Storm (2nd Vice President), Bob Antes (3rd Vice President), Bary Porter (Treasurer), and Justin Read (Secretary). Duane Craig moved the 2010 officers continue for 2011. Bill Eagleburger seconded. Motion passed. Bary Porter stated that he heard the train again.

The President talked about the Ag. Hall and the need to help support it. He had Board of Governors applications and Farmers Walk of Fame Order forms for interested individuals. Hopefully, club members will financially support it. Frank Van Fleet and John Didde spoke favorable of the Ag. Hall.

The President talked about donations made last year and the ones the club could consider for 2011. Wes Storm moved the club donate \$1,000 to the Ag. Hall for 2011. John Didde seconded. Frank Van Fleet stated the club Board of Governors donation (\$200) could be included within the \$1,000. Motion passed. Duane Craig moved the club donate \$250 in 2010 to Harvesters. Bryce York seconded. Motion passed. Dan Hanna moved the club table a \$750 donation to the Dream Factory until after the tractor cruise in May and then we could do it in the June meeting. Justin Read seconded. Motion passed. Wes Storm moved the club table a donation to Powell Gardens until after our Feb. 2011 meeting. Dan Hanna seconded. Motion passed.

The meetings scheduled for 2011 were discussed. Feb. 13, 2011 (Powell Gardens), April 3, 2011 (Barbecue, Overland Tow - Joe Meyer), June 5, 2011 (Picnic - Ag. Hall), and Nov. 6, 2011 (Adrian, MO - Duane Craig). Any time there is a meeting the starting time is 2:00 p.m. -- if there is food involved, it is 1:00 p.m. The above guidelines supersedes any errors in the newsletter.

The Western Farm Show in Kansas City, MO scheduled for Feb. 25-27, 2011 was discussed. The three day show will start on Friday and run through Sunday. Trivia Answer:

The John Deere Holt was a forklift built by John Deere and the Holt Equipment Co. The forklifts were based on the Utility chassis of the 420 and 430. Deere provided the basic tractor, with the following modifications; No rear wheels/hubs, No front axle, No mechanical steering parts, Four speed transmission with direction reverser, Crankshaft driven hydraulic pump, Full width grill guard, Power steering pump used to control hydraulic cylinder for steering. The bare tractor was mounted to a forklift frame and running gear, provided by Holt. All were mounted on a tricycle front. Most of the forklifts used a gasoline engine, but at least one was fitted with an LPG (propane) engine.

420-3T forklift--25 built, from 1956-1958

C.J. 237- forklifts assembled by Deere.

C.J. 238- forklifts assembled by Holt.

430-3T forklift--53 built, from 1959-1960

C.J. 606- forklifts assembled by Deere.

C.J. 607- forklifts assembled by Holt.

The 440I series forklifts (wheel versions) were built by the Henry Mfg. Co., of Topeka, KS, thus ending the JD Holt forklift line.
