



November Meeting / Auction - Nov. 3, 2013



GKCTC Club Meeting and White Elephant Auction

November 3, 2013, 2:00 PM

Attendance: 40+

Meeting Minutes:

President opened the meeting with the flag salute. He thanked Kenny and Portia Read for hosting the November meeting and white elephant auction.

Wes Storm provided a prayer for Glenn Ratzlaff and then followed up with information on Glenn's tractor / car accident on Saturday at the Halloween Parade in Independence, MO. Bob Antes assisted in providing up to date information. George Reed provided a card for everyone to sign for Glenn and Linda.

Wes Storm moved approval of the June meeting minutes as presented in the July-August newsletter and Bryce York seconded. Motion passed.

Treasurer Jay Pruett presented a financial report. He provided expenditures and income since June with a present \$8,256.12 in the bank. Donations for 2014 were discussed since it was suggested by the treasurer the club could donate around \$1,000. Bryce York moved to accept the financial report and Bob Antes seconded. Motion passed.

Bary Porter moved the club donate \$500 to the Ag Hall and \$500 to Harvesters for 2014. Wes Storm seconded. Motion passed. It was intended the Governorship at the Ag Hall be continued for 2014 (an additional \$200).

What constitutes a tractor cruise and a parade were discussed. There was a general consensus that a tractor cruise should consist of tractors only while a parade could be made up of a variety of vehicles. A committee will finalize the guidelines for the two activities. Bryce York moved the club schedule the Ag Hall Tractor Cruise for Saturday, May 3, 2014 and Bill Eagleburger seconded. Motion passed. Wes Storm suggested we clarify with the insurance company. Justin Read suggested we assign this to a group or committee to finalize the topic. Wes Storm moved the guidelines for the tractor cruise be discussed by the board and finalized at the February meeting and Bryce York seconded. Motion passed.

Four meeting locations for 2014 were discussed. It was suggested the February meeting (Trailside Center), April meeting (Overland Tow), June meeting (Ag Hall), and November meeting (George Reeds' Farm). Justin Read moved the recommended meeting locations as presented. Bryce York seconded. Motion passed.

Western Farm Show display on Feb. 21-23, 2014 was discussed in general. It was discussed that maybe an unstyled A, a styled A and another specialty model A be the tractors for display. A committee will determine the display by picking the tractors.

The Slate of Officers for 2014 was discussed. Bob Antes suggested he not continue to be a 3rd Vice President. Bary Porter moved the 2013 officers plus Ron Brittan as 3rd vice president be elected for 2014. Bob Antes seconded. Motion passed.

The 2014 budget committee made up of the 2014 club officers plus Bill Eagleburger and Bryce York will meet before the February meeting to establish the 2014 budget. Will meet at Bill Eagleburger's house.

The club button for 2014 was discussed. Two years ago it was determined that "Spike" Spiekers JD R tractor would be on the 2013 button and Bryce York's (JD 320) would be on the 2014 button. A picture of Bryce's tractor will be given to Bary Porter who will have the buttons made for the different functions.

Kenny Read discussed the possibility of having Tech Sessions at his place and then maybe another place in the following year. Wes Storm moved that Kenny hold a Tech Session at his place in January and Bary Porter seconded. Motion passed.

The model G John Deere began production in the middle of the John Deere Centennial Year, 1937. Manufactured: 1937 - 1953, Total built: 63,350 in Waterloo, Iowa. Cost: \$2600 (1953). Engine: Bore/ Stroke (inches): 6.5 x 7, displacement (ci): 412.5 The original Model G was rated at 20.7 drawbar and 31.44 belt horsepower. In 1953 the Model G was rated at 34.49 drawbar and 38.1 belt. The base tractor weight was 5,624 lbs. and a wheelbase of 137.5 inches. Nebraska Test: 383, June 5, 1947, Belt HP: 38.10, Drawbar HP: 34.49, Max pull (pounds): 4,394. Model G's from serial number 1000 (the first) to 4250 had a smaller radiator. This prompted over heating which called for a change to a bigger radiator. In 1942 the G was replaced with a styled Model GM. The G was the last of the lettered series to get the styling. Early in 1948 the G designation came back and the GM dropped.
