Head East on Interstate 70. Take Exit #7B - Manchester Trafficway, turn left and proceed to Gate 5 or Take Exit #9 - Blue Ridge Cutoff/Sports Complex.

##### **COMING FROM THE SOUTH**

Head North on Interstate 435. Take Exit #63 C - Raytown Road/Stadium Drive, Sports Complex exit.

##### **COMING FROM THE NORTH**

Head South on Interstate 435. Take Exit #63 B (left exit) - I-70 East/Sports Complex exit \*OR\* Take Exit# 63 A - I-70 West, then take Exit #7B - Manchester Trafficway, turn left and proceed to Gate 5.
