




Trivia Answer: The first John Deere tractor to offer factory optional live hydraulics was the Model H. The pump ran off of the governor / magneto / fan drive shaft. Also a first, the Model H's power was taken off the camshaft instead of the crankshaft. Quoted from a 1939 sales brochure: The JD Model H was manufactured to "meet the demands of small-acreage farmers everywhere for a tractor that will handle all power jobs at rock-bottom cost, and meet the demands of the large-acreage farmers who have always wanted and needed economical auxiliary power to handle lighter farm jobs, John Deere offers the new one-two plow Model H". Specs: Built 60116 from 1939-1947, Drawbar HP = 12.5, Belt HP = 14.8, Engine Displacement: 3.56" x 5.0" (99.7ci), Std. 1400 RPM, Transport 1800 RPM, Weight

= 3,035, Price New in 1940 \$650.
